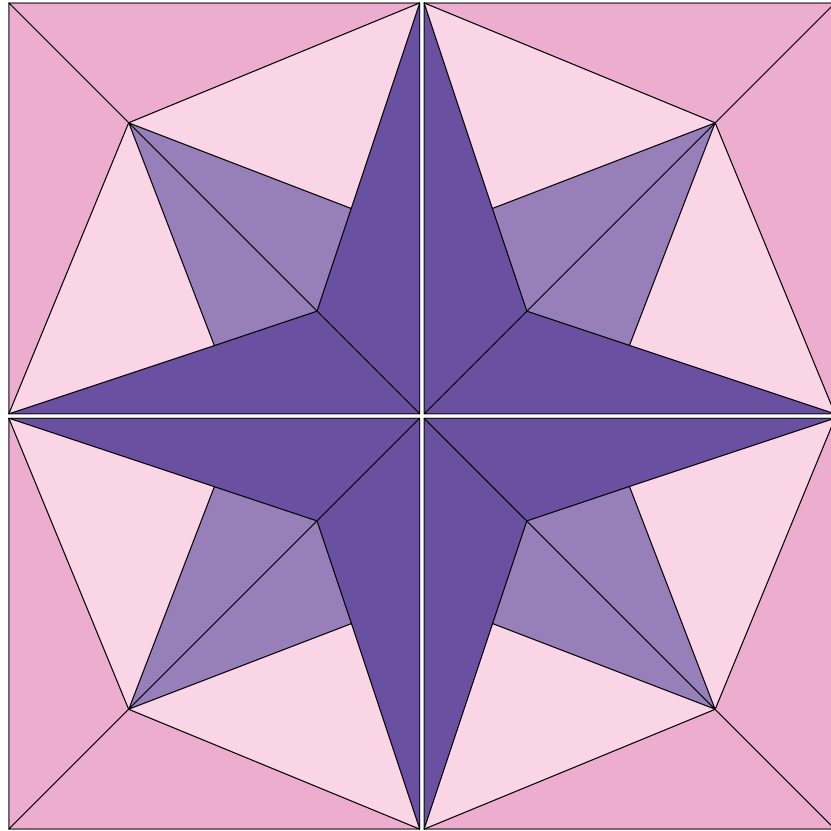


FUN WITH FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING

20 - STAR 3



STEP 1 - PRINT AND CUT THE TEMPLATES

Print the templates on page 3 onto copy paper, or, if you want to fussy cut your fabric, you might like to use tracing paper instead. Cut templates around the solid edge.

STEP 2 - PRINT THE PIECING PATTERN

You will need to make four 3 inch blocks in order to complete one star. If making just one 6 inch block, print pattern page 4 once. If you want to make a larger project, check the chart on page 2 to see how many pattern sheets to print and how many blocks to make.

STEP 3 - CUT FABRIC

Use the templates you created in step 1 to cut out your fabric. Make sure to place the template **RIGHT SIDE UP** on the **RIGHT SIDE** of your fabric. You will need four colours of fabric - Colour 1 = A1, B1 / Colour 2 = A2, B2 / Colour 3 = A3, B3 . Colour 4 = A4, B4.

STEP 4 - TIME TO SEW

Stitch the fabric parts to the pattern in numerical order. NOTE: Each 3 inch block is made up of two sections. When you have stitched all of the parts to each section, sew the sections together to make the 3 inch block. Then, stitch the four blocks together to make the complete star.

STEP 5 - NO NEED TO TRIM!

Whilst not necessary, it is a good idea to check whether you need to trim as you go. Doing so will give you neat edges to place the next pieces against.

12 Inch Block	4	4
24 Inch Block	16	16
36 Inch Square Quilt	36	36
48 Inch Square Quilt	64	64
60 Inch Square Quilt	100	100
72 Inch Square Quilt	144	144
84 Inch Square Quilt	196	196
96 Inch Square Quilt	256	256
108 Inch Square Quilt	324	324
